Time Charges

For all legal issues related to consultation activities such as reviewing documents and depositions, fieldwork, literature review, consultation with the client or other experts, report writing, travel, etc., the hourly fee is \$400. Expenses

All travel time is calculated from portal to portal. Travel time begins when I leave my office and ends when I return to my office. Retainer

A non-refundable \$5,000 retainer is required for all legal work to initiate an engagement, and no use of my name is allowed until the retainer is received. Invoicing
